COVID-19: Easter Weekend **Social distancing measures just as important during Easter**

Laval, April 10, 2020 – With Easter weekend now upon us, the Centre intégré de santé et de services sociaux (CISSS) de Laval would like to remind the public that the measures implemented to curb the spread of COVID-19 must continue to be followed in order to pursue the significant efforts already made.

While Easter is traditionally a time of celebration with family and friends, this year will be different, as the public is required to follow the social distancing measures issued by public health authorities. The safest way to stay connected to loved ones at the moment is by telephone or video chat.

It is especially important to avoid:

- all gatherings of people who are not residents of the same household
- travel from one region or city to another, unless absolutely necessary

Prevention remains the best way to protect ourselves and others. Recommendations include always staying 2 metres away from others and avoiding all physical contact for greetings (handshakes and hugs).
